WHERE IS NESCOT?

Nescot is a ten-minute walk from Ewell East station, and about 15 minutes from Ewell West. There is a large, free car park with easy access to the A3, M25, A23 and A24. On-site facilities include a nursery, sports centre, osteopathy and sports therapy clinics, a hair and beauty salon, Indian restaurant, performing arts spaces, and an outdoor activity centre.
